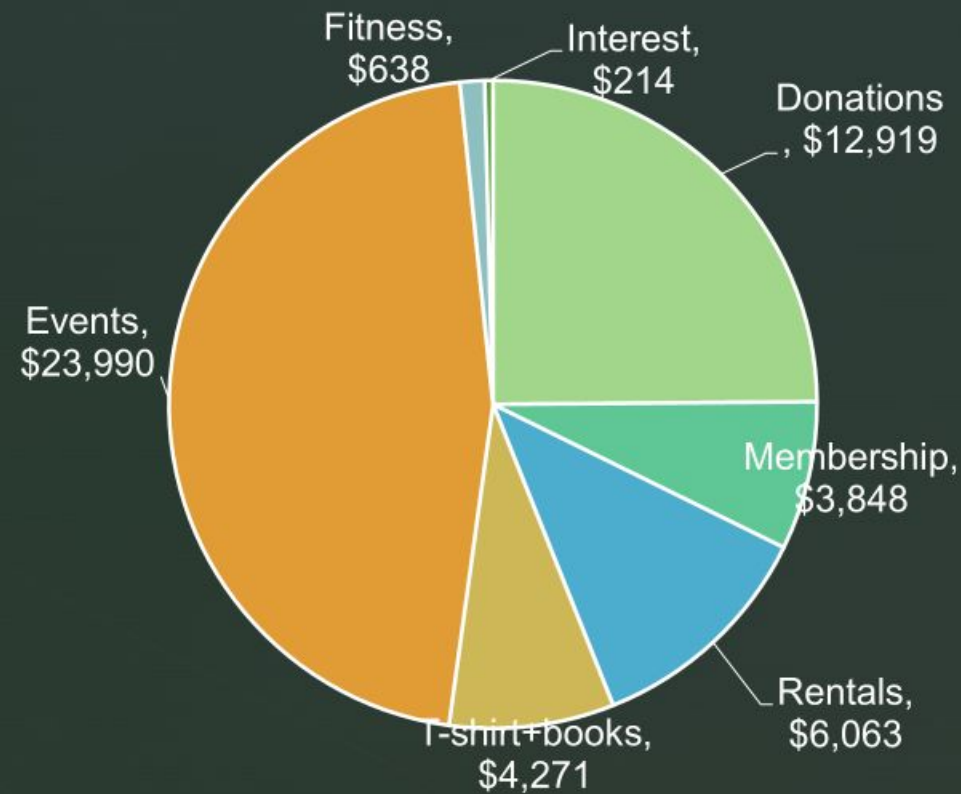
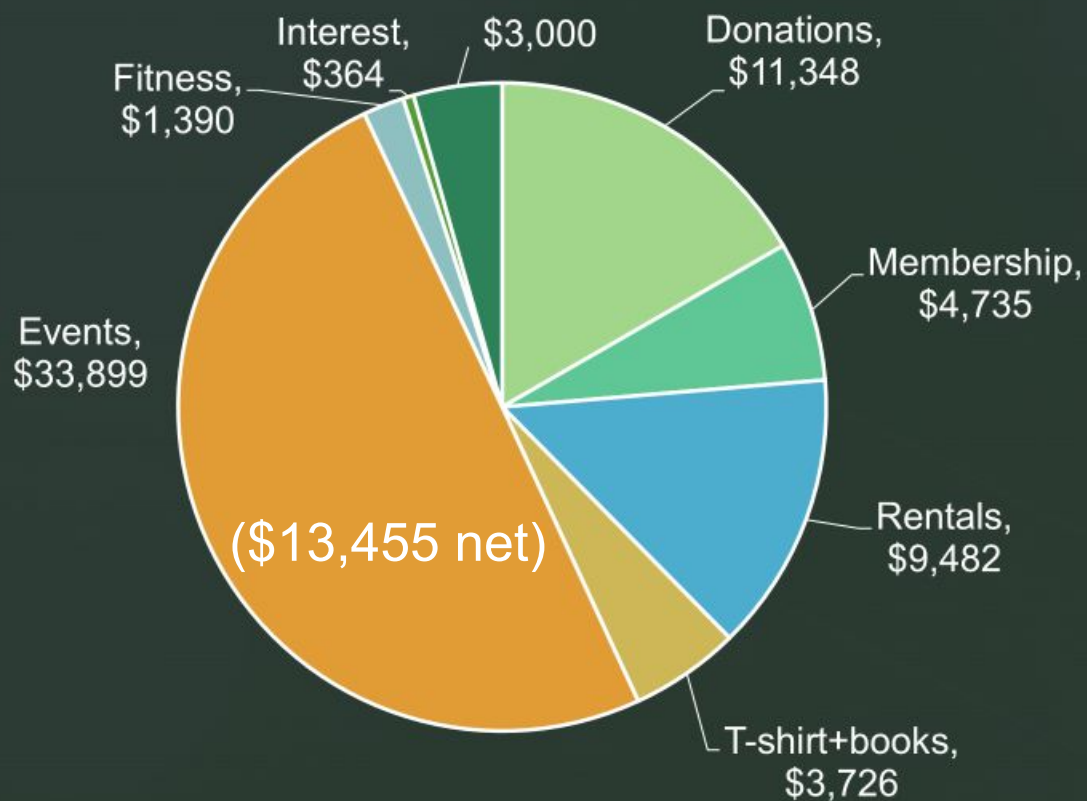

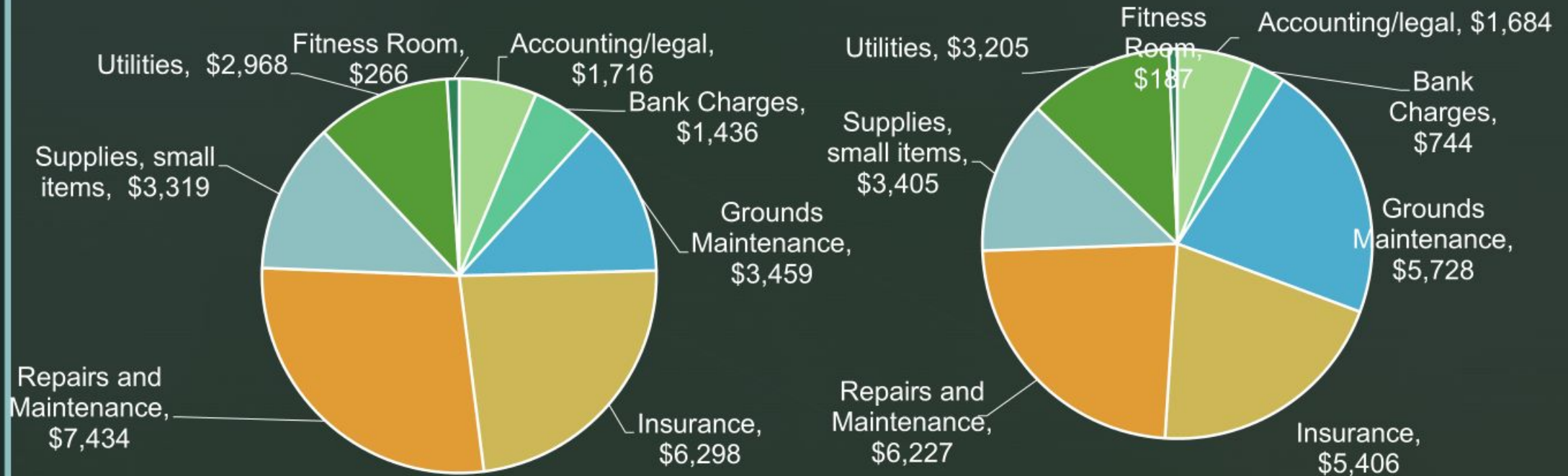

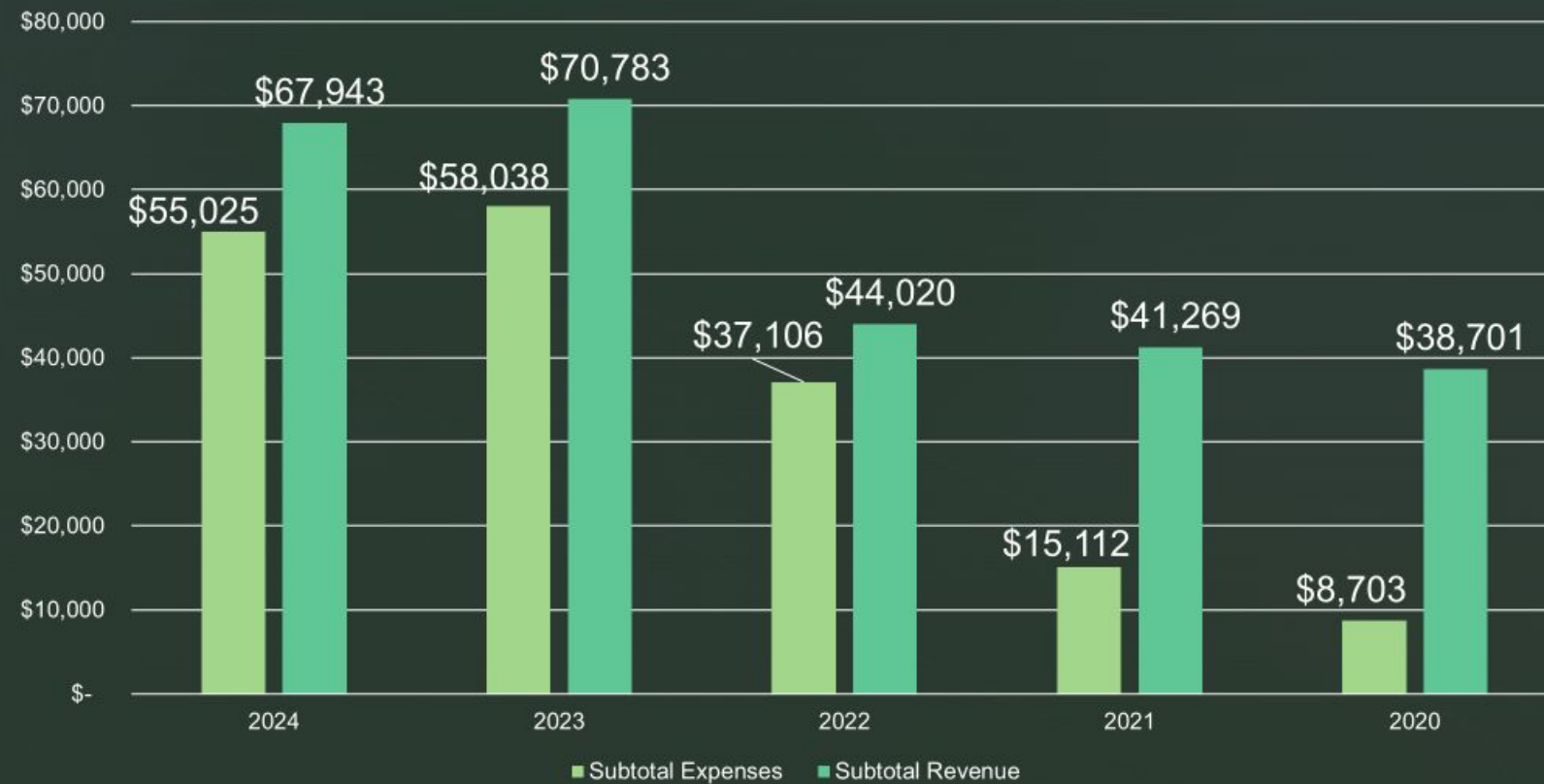
Revenue 2024 \$67,943 vs 5-year Rolling Average \$52,543



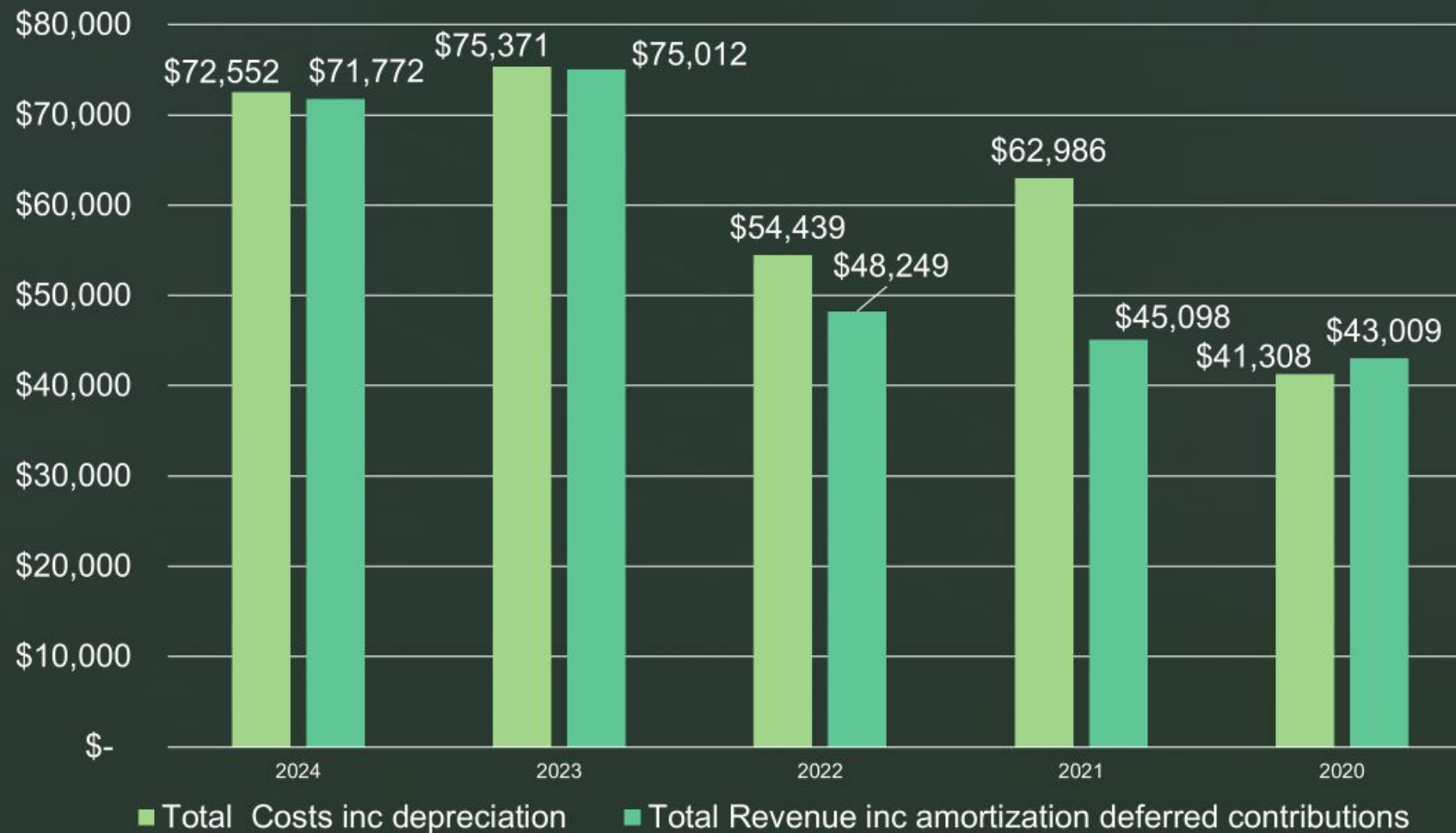
Expenses 2024 \$26,896 vs 5-Year Rolling Average \$26,856



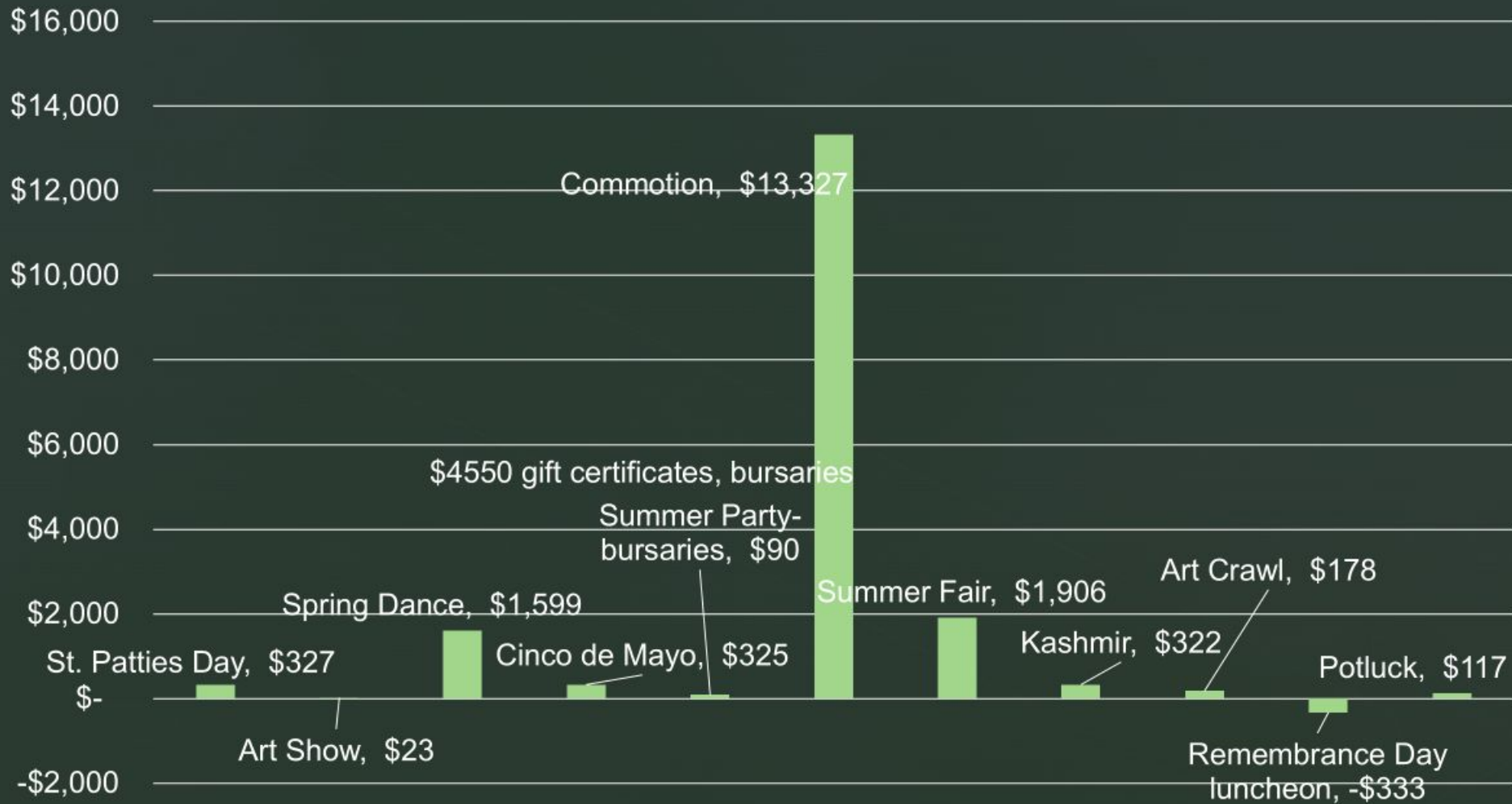
Expenses vs Revenue 2024-2024
